Technique Tips For Paper Crafting

How To Sew A Bowtie Flower A Technique A Week Series Volume 1, Issue 3

To create a bowtie flower, you can use any fabric, but usually solid colors and a little heavier weight works the best. Begin by cutting strips of fabric with pinking shears. For this flower, our strips were 1" x 5" in length. Take each piece of fabric and twist at the middle to create a bowtie. Sew in the middle with a needle & thread of a coordinating color.



Layer two pieces of sewn bowties together to form a cross. Do the same with another two pieces. Layer those together forming your flower and sew in the middle.



Complete your flower by adding a painted smaller coordinating colored flower to the center and a large brad. You can accent these flowers in a variety of ways and even paint the edges or ink them for a shabby chic look.
