Technique Tips For Paper Crafting

How To Use Floral Patterned Paper In A Unique Way A Technique A Week Series Volume 1, Issue 7

When choosing floral patterned paper, try to pick a unique sheet that has a border along the right edge of the page. When looking at the paper, instead of using it to cut flowers out, think of how you can scallop the edge and use it as a frame for your photos.



With this sheet, we used an Xacto knife and cut the pumpkin colored flowers at the left edges and lifted them off the paper to frame the mounting cards. We also cut a small slit in each stem and then laced sheer ribbon through it and tied it around the stem.



To complete the flower, we put a crunched up circle in the middle of it and then a smaller circle of felt. It was an easy way to use a sheet of patterned paper, yet give it some dimension and depth without adding any cost.

I hope you enjoy this technique and it gives you a different way to use your floral patterns. Go check out your stash and see what you have that has flowers on it that you just weren't sure how you were going to use it and now you know!! See you next week!
